1. 1/we received a general price list prior to discussing prices, services or merchandise, including a casket price list.

2. 1/we were advised that embalming is not required by California law if the selected services are direct cremation, immediate burial, or a closed casket funeral without viewing or visitation provided that refrigeration/alternative care is available.

3. 1/we were not told that any laws requires a casket for direct cremation or that a casket other than an alternative container is required for either direct cremation or direct disposition. ALTERNATIVE CONTAINERS ENCASE THE BODY AND CAN BE MADE OF MATERIALS LIKE FIBERBOARD OR COMPOSITION MATERIALS (WITH OR WITHOUT AN OUTSIDE COVERING). CREMATORIES HAVE A MINIMUM REQUIREMENT AS TO THE TYPE OF RIGIDITY OF CREMATION CONTAINERS.

4. No claims were made as to the merchandise or other service offerings of this firm that embalming or the use of any merchandise available would delay the natural decomposition of the remains for long term or indefinite time or would protect the remains from gravesite substances. No representations or warranties were made about the protective features of the caskets with a sealing device or outer burial containers other than those made by the manufacturer.

5. The only warranties, expressed or implied, granted in connection with goods sold with the funeral services selected and arranged were the express written warranties, if any, extended by the manufacturers thereof. No other warranties and no warranties of merchandising fitness or a particular purpose were extended.
